

GENERAL RULES TO READ BEFORE PRACTICING THE ACTIVITY



PARK DESCRIPTION

TrampôForest Park is a place of fun activities allowing practitioners to move independently both in height and on the ground. The park consists of different nets at height, a tree climbing structure for pitchouins and sports activities (disc golf, archery tag, escape game, treasure hunt, ground games).

ACCESS AND BEHAVIOR

- Respect for others is mandatory: no violence, intimidation or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated.
- Visitors must behave responsibly in all circumstances and take care of themselves, others, and the equipment.
- Respect the current signage and do not disturb practitioners by staying in the dedicated lanes.
- Alcohol and dangerous objects are prohibited.
- Animals (dogs) must be kept on a leash, under the supervision of their owner, and must remain in the aisles dedicated to companions on the ground.
- Access to technical areas, workshops and staff premises is strictly prohibited to the public.
- Visitors must follow all staff instructions and respect the signage.
- Remain vigilant to the environment by paying attention to branches, roots, installations, etc.
- Respect the markings and ground paths to protect the natural site.
- Do not smoke or make fires. Please note that the park is located in a wooded area.
- Keep the site clean. Bins are available for selective waste sorting.
- The service provided entitles you to:
 - * **1h30 of Trampôforest** (access to certain games depending on your purchase).
 - * Watching and understanding the safety instructions.
 - * Monitoring, advice and/or possible assistance on the course or on the ground.

SECURITY AND USE OF ACTIVITIES

- It is forbidden to access a course without having the required age and package. An upgrade may be possible only with the agreement of the manager.
- Wearing clothing suitable for outdoor physical activity is strictly mandatory.
- It is necessary to remove all objects (phone, keys, wallet etc.) from your pockets, as well as all jewelry, so that nothing may fall or get caught in the nets.
- Long hair must be tied up.
- Each activity has its own rules and safety instructions that must be viewed before starting the activity.
- (Anyone who, after the explanation of the safety instructions, does not feel capable, physically or mentally, of performing the essential manipulations required for autonomous progression must refrain from practicing the activity. No refund will be granted afterward.)
- Visitors must notify staff immediately in case of injury or any problem.
- Participants must be in good health and not be affected by any physical or psychological disorder.
- Practice is prohibited for anyone who has consumed alcohol or any substance that could impair their abilities.
- The practice is not recommended for pregnant women.
- **Children must be accompanied by an adult up to the age of 14 and** must sign a parental waiver from the age of 15.
- Management declines all responsibility for unaccompanied minors.
- In case of bad weather conditions (strong wind, thunderstorms with risk of lightning, etc.), management reserves the right to temporarily or permanently evacuate the nets ? and the park for your safety.
- **We inform you that our site is under video surveillance.**

RESPONSABILITIES

- Visitors participate in the activities at their own risk, provided they comply with the safety instructions.
- Visitors must have previously taken out civil liability insurance.
- The park is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen items. Visitors remain responsible for their personal belongings.
- The park declines all responsibility in case of loss, damage or theft.
- Any incident or accident must be reported to the staff and recorded in the safety log.
- The park has civil liability insurance. Visitors must comply with the rules for this insurance to remain applicable.
- The company **Trampôforest Park** cannot be held responsible for any damage or theft that may occur in vehicles parked in the parking lot.
- The company **Trampôforest Park** declines all responsibility in case of an accident resulting from non-compliance with safety instructions.
- **Trampôforest Park** reserves the right to claim financial compensation from participants in case of loss, theft or damage to equipment.

HEALTH AND FIRST AID

- Access to the park is prohibited for people under the influence of alcohol or banned substances.
- A first aid kit is available on the site.
- Visitors must immediately report any discomfort or injury.
- In case of an emergency, staff are trained in first aid procedures.
- The intervention of external assistance (firefighters, SAMU, police) may be implemented depending on the accident or incident with the agreement of the site manager.
- **In case of evacuation, all the people present must immediately gather at the assembly point located at the entrance to the park.**

LEGAL PROVISIONS

- The park complies with the legislation in force for ERP (Establishments Receiving the Public) and leisure activities.
- Supervised activities for minors comply with Youth and Sports standards (mandatory supervision rate, safety).
- Any photo or video taken in the park may be used for promotional purposes; a sign indicates this right.
- Discrimination, harassment or any form of violence is strictly prohibited.

SANCTIONS

- Non-compliance with the regulation may lead to:
 - * Verbal warning.
 - * Temporary or permanent exclusion from the park.
 - * Prohibition from participating in activities.
- Material damage caused voluntarily may be invoiced to the responsible persons.
- **Trampôforest Park** declines all responsibility in the event of non-compliance with safety instructions or these internal regulations.
